Curbside Recycling Event Items and Prices



Major Appliances* \$15

Hot water heater, washer, dryer, stove, refrigerator (no gas ammonia refrigerators), microwave, freezer, dishwasher, residential furnace, dehumidifier, humidifier, garbage disposal, water softener, window air conditioner

* Commercial-size appliances are NOT accepted.



Tires \$4

Bike/inner tube, car, motorcycle, light truck
Larger tires: contact your hauler for quote.



Scrap Metal Free

All wood, plastic, rubber, and other non-metal items must be removed.

▶ All fluids must be drained and plastic/rubber wheels removed from lawn mowers and snow blowers.

Unacceptable Items

The following items will not be picked up:

- ▶ Household hazardous waste
- ▶ Electronics
- ▶ Household items
- ▶ Lawn and patio furniture
- ▶ Vacuum cleaners
- ▶ Wood
- ▶ Carpeting
- ▶ Construction/demolition waste
- ▶ Yard waste
- ▶ Glass and mirrors

These special reduced prices are available for this event only!

- ▶ Please note: Items that do not meet the above specifications will not be picked up by your hauler, or may be subject to additional fees as determined by the hauler.
- ▶ This event is open to **residential customers only**, and excludes businesses.

How it works



1. Call your trash hauler for a pick-up by Monday, Sept. 26

To take advantage of this one-time, reduced-fee pick-up, you MUST contact your hauler to schedule a pick-up by Monday, September 26. *No exceptions.*

*Troj's Trash & Recycling has elected not to participate in this event. Troje's customers may call *Tennis Sanitation* or *Highland Sanitation* to schedule a pick-up by Sept. 26, and take advantage of this one-time reduced fee service.

2. Pick-up happens Oct. 3-7

Pick-up will take place on a designated day the week of October 3-7. Items must be at the curb by 6 a.m. Details will be provided when you schedule your pick-up.

3. Fees for the items you dispose of will be charged by the hauler. Haulers may require payment in advance.

FREE Document Shredding Event

Bring your personal and confidential papers to be shredded on-site by Shred Right.

- Staples and paper clips do not have to be removed.
- CDs, floppy disks and other media will also be accepted for off-site destruction.
- The event is free and open to residents and businesses.
- Bring up to 6 boxes for shredding, weighing no more than 30 pounds each.
